Day 1 - Monday

Literacy

This week we are going to be looking at Earth! Listen to the story and choose your favourite page to write some sentences about. This can be about the stars in our solar system, the sea or even your body. Remember to use your sound mats (found in a link on our class page) to help you.

Maths

When we have one more, our number gets bigger and when we have one less our number gets smaller. Can you draw some planets and then find one more and one less? (video on Tapestry).

Understanding the World

Can you think about different habitats and environments (e.g. desert) people across the world live in? What is the weather like? Do all habitats look the same?

These are the main habitats that animals live in:



Personal, Social and Emotional

In the story, it talks about how everybody looks different. Can you choose someone you know that looks different to you? Are you similar in any way? What would the world be like if we were all the same?

Day 2 - Tuesday

Literacy and Technology

It is really important we look after the animals on our planet. With a grown up, can you research endangered animals. What does endangered mean? Can you choose an endangered animal to write 3 facts about?

Maths

It is always good to practise things we found tricky! Can you remember what the take away sign looks like? Make it with your arm. When we take away our number gets smaller! Can you have a go at these take away sums by drawing pictures or using objects to help you? (video on Tapestry)

Physical Development (Self-Care)

Literacy

Choose your favourite story or a story that you have never read before. Share this with an adult inside your reading den. Can you retell the story and make up some actions to go with it? Remember to take pictures or videos for us to see on Tapestry!

Maths

In your reading den can you complete this maths quiz? Your grown up can read you the questions and you try to work out the answers.

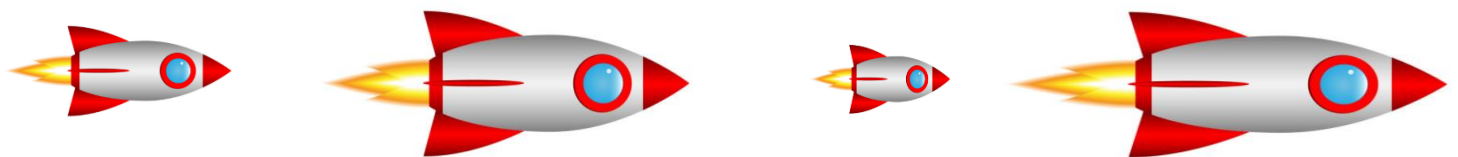

Maths

A star is a 2-D shape. Can you remember all of the 2-D shapes we have learnt? Tell them to a grown up and then listen to the shape song - how many 2-D shapes did you remember?
