Day 1 - Monday

Literacy

Can you make a list of all the different types of transport you know? Talk about what transport you use the most.

Maths

Length - what way is length? What words do we use when talking about length? Can you use the phrase 'shorter than' or 'longer than' to compare 2 different lengths. Have a go at carefully cutting out these forms of transport and ordering them from shortest to longest.





Can you talk about the size of the lorries/tractors, as well as the length? Which is the smallest/biggest? Is the shortest lorry/tractor and the smallest lorry/tractor the same?

Physical Development - To help you make your list, take a walk and see how many different types of transport you see.

Personal, Social and Emotional - Talk about road safety. How we can be safe when we are out walking or on a bike/scooter?

Day 2 - Tuesday

Literacy

Listen to 'Oi oi get off the train' and talk about the different animals on the train - children join in with repeated phrases 'oi oi get off the train!'

Can you draw a picture and write a silly sentence about an animal getting on/in a form on transport e.g. The elephant is in the blue car/The giraffe is on the black motorbike

Maths

Height - what way is height? What words do we use when talking about height? Can you find objects around your house and compare them to your height. What is shorter/taller than you?

Communication and Language - Can you find and sing some songs about transport (e.g. the wheels on the bus). You could ask your grown up to record you singing one of these songs, or have a go at making up your own song!

Understanding the World - Talk about types of transport we use to get to different places (e.g. how can we get to school? How can we get to Australia? etc)

Day 3 - Wednesday

Literacy

Practise singing your alphabet. Can you think of different types of transport for each letter of the alphabet? Have a go yourself first but use these songs if you get stuck!

Look in a magazine/newspaper (pictures online) and carefully cut out pictures of different transport to create your own picture.

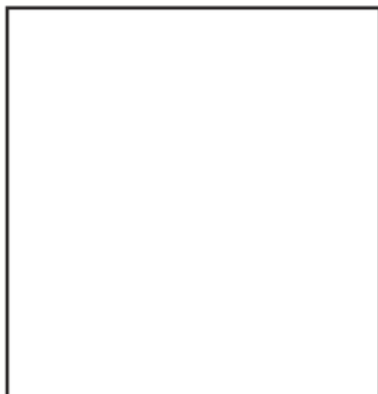


Day 4 - Thursday

Literacy

Understanding the World - Make a paper airplane and see how far it can fly and talk about why it flies.

Day 5 - Friday

Literacy

If you could fly anywhere on a plane, where would you like to go? It can be a real place or imaginary. Talk to your grown up about why you want to go there and what you would do when you get there. Use your sounds to write the sentence below and fill in the gap:

Maths

Listen and watch the video 'Where is the monkey?' (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=idJYhjGyWTU>). Talk about the different places the monkey was hiding. Game: with a grown up, can you put a toy in different places and describe where it is (e.g. it is on the table/it is under the chair)

Personal, Social and Emotional - If you were going on holiday, who would you like to go with? Why would you choose to spend time with them? How do they make you feel?

Communication and Language - Can you role play being a train driver/bus driver/riding a bike etc? What would they say?
